CONFLICT MINERAL POLICY STATEMENT

Multi Net Resources Sdn Bhd is committed to sourcing components, materials, and products from companies that are aligned and in parallel with our minimum requirement, including business requirement and global ethics requirement which including human rights protection, business ethics, safety and health, and environmental responsibility.

Natural mineral resources hold great potential for development but can, in conflict-affected or high-risk areas, be a cause of dispute where their revenues fuel the outbreak or continuation of violent conflict, undermining endeavours towards development, good governance and the rule of law. To Address such concerns, Regulation (EU) 2017/821 of the Council lays down supply chain due diligence obligations for Union importers of tin, tantalum and tungsten, their ores, and gold originating from conflict-affected and high-risk areas; which effective start from 1st January 2021.

As a responsible company who are highly concern on the business sustainability and impacts to the human living, Multi Net Resources Sdn Bhd has voluntarily joining on this program regardless of import or export activities. We have developed our program to align with the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chains of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas. We are committed to complying with any requirements applicable to our Company under the Conflict Minerals Rule. Besides, we will try our best to safeguarding our customer by understand, identify and trace the 3TG minerals that are contained within the products coming from the supply chain. As part of our due diligence efforts, Multi Net Resources Sdn Bhd will further justify the qualification of the supplier referencing to the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI) Conflict-Free Smelter Program.

Multi Net Resources Sdn Bhd will assist our customers in implementing their conflict minerals programs. We strive to work cooperatively with our customers and supply chain partners in implementing conflict minerals compliance programs. Multi Net Resources Sdn Bhd requires all of our suppliers to provide us with completed conflict minerals declarations using the RMI Conflict Minerals Reporting Template. We may reconsider our willingness to partner with suppliers that fail to comply with this Policy.
